- AMLCT/TCDSU also organises the annual Trinity Ball – Europe's largest private party in mid-April! 7000 tickets sell out in five minutes, so you gotta be quick!

Straitéis Ionadaíochta na nIarchéimithe

Postgraduate Representation Strategy

- The membership of each School Executive Committee details that the two student representatives must consist of one undergraduate and one postgraduate. While we recognise that PGT and PGR face a number of different issues, we must work within the confines of the statutes for now, and as such we propose the integration of all PGs (PGT + PGR) into the UG Faculty Assembly structure.
- In recognising the demanding schedules of PGRs, it is impractical to expect them to attend additional meetings beyond their extensive research, academic and life commitments. By incorporating PGs into the existing UG Faculty Assembly structure, both UG and PG concerns can be addressed in a single forum
- We propose that following the election of the PGR and PGT representatives, we should hold elections for the PG School and Faculty Convenors at the first meeting of each respective Faculty Assembly. This will allow for both PGT students and PGRs to have the opportunity to put themselves forward for the election. The election process will be overseen by the TCDSU/AMLCT Electoral Commission, ensuring fairness and transparency, and all of the same rules which apply to the UG School and Faculty Convenor elections shall apply here (i.e., only representatives from a certain school may vote for the convenor for that school).
- These assemblies should endeavour to meet twice a term, and will elect the new PG Faculty Convenor, Deputy and School Convenors at the first meeting of the academic year.

- **Tabharfar faoi deara an t-amchlár fairsing ag na nIarchéimithe, beidh bearta sonracha ann a bheidh dírithe ar ainmniúcháin Iarchéime a fháil i rith a seachtaine ionduchtaithe ar an 2 Meán Fómhair. Ina dhiaidh sin leanfar le feachtas cuimsitheach a dhíreoidh ar gach cohóirt ón 16 Meán Fómhair go dtí an 27 Meán Fómhair.**
- **Toghcháin idir 2-4 Deireadh Fómhair. Fógrófar na torthaí ar 7 Deireadh Fómhair.**
- **Beidh traenáil d'ionadaithe nuathofa ar siúl ar an 12 agus 13 Deireadh Fómhair, roimh ár gcéad Chomhairle ar an 15 Deireadh Fómhair. Beidh traenáil ar siúl i Mount Wolseley i gContae Cheatharlach, agus beidh fanacht thar oíche i gceist**
- **Maidir le poist ar Bhord na hOllscoile, ar Chomhairle na hOllscoile, agus ar na príomhchoistí atá acu, molaimid nuair a bhíonn dhá phost ag Iarchéimithe gur cheart post amháin a chur in áirithe do ICT agus an ceann eile do ICM. Is é an tOifigeach ICM lánaimseartha a líonfaidh gach post ICM leithdháilte ar choistí coláiste.**
- **Nominations: Postgraduate (PGR + PGT):** Open from 2nd September to 27th September.
- **Undergraduate Students (UGs):** Open from 16th September to 27th September.
- **You will note the extensive timeframe for nominations for PGs, there will be specific measures aimed at securing PG nominations during their orientation week on the 2nd of September. This will then be followed with a comprehensive campaign targeting all cohorts from the 16th of September until the 27th of September.**
- **Elections scheduled for 2nd, 3rd, and 4th October. Results will be announced on 7th October.**
- **Training for newly elected representatives will take place on the 12th and 13th October, ahead of our first TCDSU/AMLCT Council on the 15th of October. Training will take place in Mount Wolseley in County Carlow, and it will be an overnight stay.**
- **With regards to positions on University Board, University Council, and their principle committees, we propose that where there are two positions allocated for postgraduates that one position should be reserved for a PGR and the other for a PGT. All allocated PGT positions on college committees shall be filled by the full-time PGT Officer.**
